## Leftover Iced-tea?

People always tell me that they don't want to brew up a pitcher of iced-tea because they won't drink it all in one day. I now have a solution for them. Try making tea-pops or Tea-ice cubes! It is a really easy, healthy and affordable way to have a refreshing treat without all the calories like high fructose corn syrup popsicles have. Just put the tea in some popsicle molds with a few pieces of fresh fruit or if it sounds good mix it with a little orange juice or lemonade to add a little sweetness, freeze and enjoy your tea-sicle. Just replace the water with tea and you have a delicious rice made with tea.
